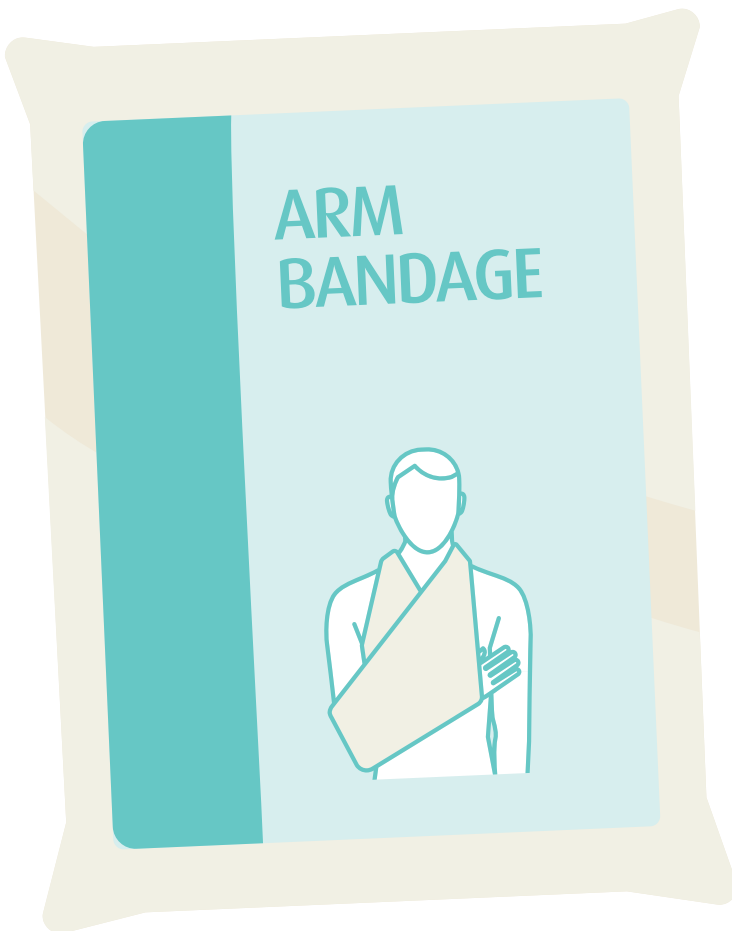

How does it work?

Who can get coverage?

You	If you're actively at work*
Your spouse	Ages 17 to 64
Your children	Dependent children from birth until their 26th birthday, regardless of marital or student status.

How much does it cost?

You and your child(ren)	\$7.02
You, your spouse and child(ren)	\$9.34
